SALVATION IS...

1. **What is Salvation?** Salvation is a union of eternal life with God in Jesus Christ, as a child of God.
2. **Why must you be Saved?** God loves you so much that He has a wonderful plan for you - that you may have eternal life and enjoy it to the full in personal fellowship with Him! But because you are a sinner you can't!

All human beings are born as sinners. A man sins because he is a sinner. The Bible says "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. There is no one righteous, not even one." That is why you must be saved.

3. **How can you be Saved?** Repent! Turn from your sins and to God, and accept Jesus Christ in your heart as your personal Savior and Lord. Believe that He died on the cross for your sin and rose again from the dead for your salvation and will again come in bodily form. And then you will be saved.

4. **When and Where can you be Saved?** Now and here is the most suitable time and place for you to be saved! Our life on this earth is like a mist which appears and disappears quickly. Or like a flower which blooms and soon fades. The Bible says "Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth, so 'Now is the time of God's favor, Now is the day of salvation.'"

5. **Who can Save you?** Only Jesus can save you! Nobody but Jesus can save you and me! Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life, no one can come to the Father except through me. I give [those who believe in me] eternal life, they shall never perish, no one can snatch them out of my hand. I am the resurrection and life, he who believes in me will live even though he dies, he will rise again and live forever."

Also, the Bible says, "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved—that name is Jesus Christ!"

1:1 The word of the LORD that came to Hosea son of Beeri during the reigns of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz and Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and during the reign of Jeroboam son of Jehoash king of Israel: ... >>>

4:1 Hear the word of the LORD, you Israelites, because the LORD has a charge to bring against you who live in the land: "There is no faithfulness, no love, no acknowledgment of God in the land.

11:7 My people are determined to turn from me. Even though they call me God Most High, I will by no means exalt them. 8 "How can I give you up, Ephraim? How can I hand you over, Israel? How can I treat you like Admah? How can I make you like Zeboyim? My heart is changed within me; all my compassion is aroused. 9 I will not carry out my fierce anger, nor will I devastate Ephraim again. For I am God, and not a man—the Holy One among you. 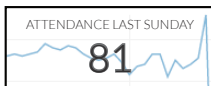

SERMON NOTES

Hosea 1

1 The word of the LORD that came to Hosea son of Beeri during the reigns of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz and Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and during the reign of Jeroboam son of Jehoash king of Israel: 2 When the LORD began to speak through Hosea, the LORD said to him, "Go, marry a promiscuous woman and have children with her, for like an adulterous wife this land is guilty of unfaithfulness to the LORD." 3 So he married Gomer daughter of Diblaim, and she conceived and bore him a son. 4 Then the LORD said to Hosea, "Call him Jezreel, because I will soon punish the house of Jehu for the massacre at Jezreel, and I will put an end to the kingdom of Israel. 5 In that day I will break Israel's bow in the Valley of Jezreel." 6 Gomer conceived again and gave birth to a daughter. Then the LORD said to Hosea, "Call

her Lo-Ruhamah (which means "not loved"), for I will no longer show love to Israel, that I should at all forgive them. 7 Yet I will show love to Judah; and I will save them—not by bow, sword or battle, or by horses and horsemen, but I, the LORD their God, will save them." 8 After she had weaned Lo-Ruhamah, Gomer had another son. 9 Then the LORD said, "Call him Lo-Ammi (which means "not my people"), for you are not my people, and I am not your God. 10 "Yet the Israelites will be like the sand on the seashore, which cannot be measured or counted. In the place where it was said to them, 'You are not my people,' they will be called 'children of the living God.' 11 The people of Judah and the people of Israel will come together; they will appoint one leader and will come up out of the land, for great will be the day of Jezreel.
