SALVATION IS...

1. **What is Salvation?** Salvation is a union of eternal life with God in Jesus Christ, as a child of God.
2. **Why must you be Saved?** God loves you so much that He has a wonderful plan for you - that you may have eternal life and enjoy it to the full in personal fellowship with Him! But because you are a sinner you can't!

All human beings are born as sinners. A man sins because he is a sinner. The Bible says "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. There is no one righteous, not even one." That is why you must be saved.

3. **How can you be Saved?** Repent! Turn from your sins and to God, and accept Jesus Christ in your heart as your personal Savior and Lord. Believe that He died on the cross for your sin and rose again from the dead for your salvation and will again come in bodily form. And then you will be saved.

4. **When and Where can you be Saved?** Now and here is the most suitable time and place for you to be saved! Our life on this earth is like a mist which appears and disappears quickly. Or like a flower which blooms and soon fades. The Bible says "Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth, so 'Now is the time of God's favor, Now is the day of salvation.'"

5. **Who can Save you?** Only Jesus can save you! Nobody but Jesus can save you and me! Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life, no one can come to the Father except through me. I give [those who believe in me] eternal life, they shall never perish, no one can snatch them out of my hand. I am the resurrection and life, he who believes in me will live even though he dies, he will rise again and live forever."

Also, the Bible says, "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved—that name is Jesus Christ!"

Zechariah 1:1-21, 8:3, 9:9

1:1 In the eighth month of the second year of Darius, the word of the LORD came to the prophet Zechariah son of Berekhiah, the son of Iddo: 2 "The LORD was very angry with your ancestors... >>>

SERMON NOTES

Zechariah 1

1 In the eighth month of the second year of Darius, the word of the LORD came to the prophet Zechariah son of Berekiah, the son of Iddo: 2 "The LORD was very angry with your ancestors. 3 Therefore tell the people: This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'Return to me,' declares the LORD Almighty, 'and I will return to you,' says the LORD Almighty. 4 Do not be like your ancestors, to whom the earlier prophets proclaimed: This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'Turn from your evil ways and your evil practices.' But they would not listen or pay attention to me, declares the LORD. 5 Where are your ancestors now? And the prophets, do they live forever? 6 But did not my words and my decrees, which I commanded my servants the prophets, overtake your ancestors? "Then they repented and said, 'The LORD Almighty has done to us what our ways and practices deserve, just as he determined to do.' " 7 On the twenty-fourth day of the eleventh month, the month of Shebat, in the second year of Darius, the word of the LORD came to the prophet Zechariah son of Berekiah, the son of Iddo. 8 During the night I had a vision, and there before me was a man mounted on a red horse. He was standing among the myrtle trees in a ravine. Behind him were red, brown and white horses. 9 I asked, "What are these, my lord?" The angel who was talking with me answered, "I will show you what they are." 10 Then the man standing among the myrtle trees explained, "They are the ones the LORD has sent to go throughout the earth." 11 And they reported to the angel of the LORD who

was standing among the myrtle trees, "We have gone throughout the earth and found the whole world at rest and in peace." 12 Then the angel of the LORD said, "LORD Almighty, how long will you withhold mercy from Jerusalem and from the towns of Judah, which you have been angry with these seventy years?" 13 So the LORD spoke kind and comforting words to the angel who talked with me. 14 Then the angel who was speaking to me said, "Proclaim this word: This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'I am very jealous for Jerusalem and Zion, 15 and I am very angry with the nations that feel secure. I was only a little angry, but they went too far with the punishment.' 16 "Therefore this is what the LORD says: 'I will return to Jerusalem with mercy, and there my house will be rebuilt. And the measuring line will be stretched out over Jerusalem,' declares the LORD Almighty. 17 "Proclaim further: This is what the LORD Almighty says: 'My towns will again overflow with prosperity, and the LORD will again comfort Zion and choose Jerusalem.' " 18 Then I looked up, and there before me were four horns. 19 I asked the angel who was speaking to me, "What are these?" He answered me, "These are the horns that scattered Judah, Israel and Jerusalem." 20 Then the LORD showed me four craftsmen. 21 I asked, "What are these coming to do?" He answered, "These are the horns that scattered Judah so that no one could raise their head, but the craftsmen have come to terrify them and throw down these horns of the nations who lifted up their horns against the land of Judah to scatter its people."
