**SALVATION IS...**

1. **What is Salvation?** Salvation is a union of eternal life with God in Jesus Christ, as a child of God.
2. **Why must you be Saved?** God loves you so much that He has a wonderful plan for you - that you may have eternal life and enjoy it to the full in personal fellowship with Him! But because you are a sinner you can't!

All human beings are born as sinners. A man sins because he is a sinner. The Bible says "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. There is no one righteous, not even one." That is why you must be saved.

3. **How can you be Saved?** Repent! Turn from your sins and to God, and accept Jesus Christ in your heart as your personal Savior and Lord. Believe that He died on the cross for your sin and rose again from the dead for your salvation and will again come in bodily form. And then you will be saved.

4. **When and Where can you be Saved?** Now and here is the most suitable time and place for you to be saved! Our life on this earth is like a mist which appears and disappears quickly. Or like a flower which blooms and soon fades. The Bible says "Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth, so 'Now is the time of God's favor, Now is the day of salvation.'"

5. **Who can Save you?** Only Jesus can save you! Nobody but Jesus can save you and me! Jesus says, "I am the way, the truth, and the life, no one can come to the Father except through me. I give [those who believe in me] eternal life, they shall never perish, no one can snatch them out of my hand. I am the resurrection and life, he who believes in me will live even though he dies, he will rise again and live forever."

Also, the Bible says, "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved—that name is Jesus Christ!"



**Malachi 1:1-14, 2:17, 3:1, 4:5-6**

1:1 A prophecy: The word of the LORD to Israel through Malachi. 2 "I have loved you," says the LORD. "But you ask, 'How have you loved us?' .... >>>

2:17 You have wearied the LORD with your words. "How have we wearied him?" you ask. By saying, "All who do evil are good in the eyes of the LORD, and he is pleased with them" or "Where is the God of justice?"

3:1 "I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come," says the LORD Almighty.

## SERMON NOTES

### Malachi 1

1 A prophecy: The word of the LORD to Israel through Malachi. 2 “I have loved you,” says the LORD. “But you ask, ‘How have you loved us?’ “Was not Esau Jacob’s brother?” declares the LORD. “Yet I have loved Jacob, 3 but Esau I have hated, and I have turned his hill country into a wasteland and left his inheritance to the desert jackals.” 4 Edom may say, “Though we have been crushed, we will rebuild the ruins.” But this is what the LORD Almighty says: “They may build, but I will demolish. They will be called the Wicked Land, a people always under the wrath of the LORD. 5 You will see it with your own eyes and say, ‘Great is the LORD—even beyond the borders of Israel!’ 6 “A son honors his father, and a slave his master. If I am a father, where is the honor due me? If I am a master, where is the respect due me?” says the LORD Almighty. “It is you priests who show contempt for my name. “But you ask, ‘How have we shown contempt for your name?’ 7 “By offering defiled food on my altar. “But you ask, ‘How have we defiled you?’ “By saying that the LORD’s table is contemptible. 8 When you offer blind animals for sacrifice, is that not wrong? When you sacrifice lame or diseased animals, is that not wrong? Try offering them to your

governor! Would he be pleased with you? Would he accept you?” says the LORD Almighty. 9 “Now plead with God to be gracious to us. With such offerings from your hands, will he accept you?”—says the LORD Almighty. 10 “Oh, that one of you would shut the temple doors, so that you would not light useless fires on my altar! I am not pleased with you,” says the LORD Almighty, “and I will accept no offering from your hands. 11 My name will be great among the nations, from where the sun rises to where it sets. In every place incense and pure offerings will be brought to me, because my name will be great among the nations,” says the LORD Almighty. 12 “But you profane it by saying, ‘The Lord’s table is defiled,’ and, ‘Its food is contemptible.’ 13 And you say, ‘What a burden!’ and you sniff at it contemptuously,” says the LORD Almighty. “When you bring injured, lame or diseased animals and offer them as sacrifices, should I accept them from your hands?” says the LORD. 14 “Cursed is the cheat who has an acceptable male in his flock and vows to give it, but then sacrifices a blemished animal to the Lord. For I am a great king,” says the LORD Almighty, “and my name is to be feared among the nations.
